Magnet Game for Learning Letters

The Game Contains:

- 52 Letters: 26 lowercase letters (abc) and 26 capital letters (ABC)
- 13 magnetic boards of the following drawings:

airplane, bottle, cake, doll, elephant, feather, gift, hammer, ice cream, jellyfish, king, lion, moon, nut, octopus, pear, queen, rooster, shoe, turtle, umbrella, vase, watermelon, xylophone, yellow, zebra.

Aim of the Game:

Teach your toddler capital and lowercase letters, opening letters, and matching capital to lowercase letters.

Stage 1:

Teach your child the capital letters and the lowercase letters and how to arrange them in alphabetical order.

*We recommend that a parent or adult sits with the child and practices the alphabetical order by completing missing letters from the sequence and matching capital letters to small letters.

Stage 2:

Play a memory game to practice matching capital and small letters. Select capital and small letters pairs and turn them over. The player with the most pairs is the winner.

Stage 3:

Have your child place the opening letters of each illustration on the magnetic boards.

Stage 4:

Have your child match the capital letter to the small letter.

*We recommend that a parent or adult sits with the child and practices the capital letters with the appropriate illustration and let the child complete the appropriate lowercase letters.

Later, once the child proficiently identifies and matches the letters, they can independently place the capital and small letters on the board based on the illustrations.

Free game:

Using the magnetic letters, freely create words on the magnetic board, refrigerator, etc.

A fun educational game.
